This course is appropriate for the beginning or experienced actor. Students will have a chance to experience many elements of theater - creativity, improvisation, auditions, vocal techniques for the stage, collaboration, costume and prop design, and more. Students will have the opportunity to explore their favorite theater techniques and genres more deeply while being exposed to different styles of theater as well, through observational and experiential learning. At the end of each semester students will have the opportunity to showcase what they've learned.

Homework expectations:

Homework activities will be assigned that can take 1-5 hours to complete outside of class. The general expectation will be approximately 1-2 hours, but students looking for a full credit will have an additional 2-3 hours of optional enrichment activities to complete for a full semester credit.
