This one-semester class will be offered Fall semester only.

Students will explore the founding and organic documents by which Americans govern themselves: foundational Biblical world view; The Declaration of Independence; The Northwest Ordinance of 1787; the United States Constitution. Next, the students will study those institutions that today affect exactly how American government really works: Congress and Legislatures; Courts; President and Governor; the media; political parties and lobbyists; grass roots activists. Tuition of \$265 includes all printed materials including workbook, books, and papers.

This course is the Prerequisite for Spring Semester, Student Senate
