Typically a 10th grade course, students taking biology will study...

- classification systems of organisms,
- components and processes of the cell,
- organic chemistry,
- genetics,
- botany, ecology, and
- zoology.

Students develop research and presentation skills through written and oral reports. This course provides opportunity for dissection and study of the intricacies of plant and animal life.
