This is a full-year class. Tuition shown is for the year and may be paid in two installments (August 13, 2023, and January 5, 2024).

Journalism introduces students to the exciting world of print, online, and broadcast media. During the year, students will learn about and practice a variety of journalistic activities including interviewing, investigative reporting, writing (news, reviews, opinion, sports, obituaries, human interest features, etc.), editing, advertising, design, deadlines, and teamwork. In addition, they'll learn about the history of journalism and be able to practice media literacy--knowing how to interpret media and whom to believe. When the class is ready, students will begin writing, editing, and publishing Mid-Metro Academy's first student newspaper. They'll become familiar with Canva.com templates and functions as they work together to design and publish the paper. Out-of-class time will be required, and students will need to comply with deadlines to put the paper to bed and get it released on time. This is a year-long class, but it's open to mid-year entry with the consent of the instructor/adviser, Mrs. Hope.
