Class times will be fun and low-anxiety, with a focus on discussion and conversation about stories, what makes them tick, examples in popular media, and dissecting how every element of the way a story is told affects the other elements; from the visuals to the metaphors, from the writing to the acting, from the music to the cinematography. Your workload is up to you--you will make cool art more than once, but the effort you put in is up to you. You get out of the class what you put in by participating in discussion and allowing work you create to be critiqued and peer-reviewed.
