Teamwork and leadership are skills that can be very beneficial as students and in future career opportunities. This class is designed to work with students at a variety of levels - students who want to increase their confidence to become leaders, students who want to learn how they can be leaders without having to be "in charge," students who are already strong leaders and want to make sure they are also team players. Students will also explore teamwork in a variety of different settings and roles. This course will include a self-inventory for students to reflect on their own teamwork and leadership skills throughout the class, as their own definitions of being on a team or being a leader change. Topics will include Christian leadership, conflict resolution, respecting differences, and more.

Homework expectations:

Homework activities will be assigned that can take 1-5 hours to complete outside of class. The general expectation will be approximately 1-2 hours, but students looking for a full credit will have an additional 2-3 hours of optional enrichment activities to complete for a full semester credit.
